

Check-in assessment for Years 3-6

Year 3-6 students will participate in a reading and numeracy Check-in assessment later this term when we've all returned to face-to-face learning.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning. The assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. For further information about the check-in assessment, please speak to your child's teacher.
