#### Classroom Costs 2019

Payments and part payments can be made online using our school website or at our office during school hours. Please ensure payments for student resource packs are finalised by the end of term 1 to ensure students can begin using resources.

Student Resource Pack - \$70 per student covers classroom resources (whiteboard markers, paint, crayons, pastels etc), school magazine subscriptions, maths online programs to support class programs, classroom exercise books, text books (3-6), home reading diary (K-2) and other miscellaneous items.

School Fees - \$35 per student voluntary school contributions go towards the purchase of resources/materials that are used for class work each day and paper/ photocopying supplies.
